EQUIPMENT ELECTRICIAN 543

DUTIES: Diagnoses and repairs electrical equipment on GCRTA vehicles. Replaces wiring harnesses; repairs open or shorted connections; tests electrical components and traces circuits to determine the source of electrical problems. Repairs/replaces electrical components such as switches, relays, generators, and bulbs. Provides technical direction and assistance to Grade 4 Equipment Servicers and Equipment Maintainers concerning diagnosis, repair, and maintenance of electrical equipment on coaches. Performs other duties of a similar nature as may be required.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must have successfully completed technical courses covering electrical systems theory, diagnosis, and repair, taken at the high school or post-high school level. Applicants must have two (2) years of verifiable experience diagnosing and repairing bus electrical systems. Applicants must have a valid STATE OF OHIO COMMERCIAL DRIVERS LICENSE (CDL) Class "A" or "B" with Airbrake and Passenger endorsements or submit PASSING SCORES FROM THE WRITTEN TEMPORARY CDL EXAM, Class "A" or "B" with Airbrake and Passenger endorsements. Applicants must have a GOOD DRIVING RECORD, with no more than FOUR (4) POINTS, in the past three years.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The performance of these duties may be required at any time of the day or night, any day and/or night of the week. The position is a bargaining unit position. The position is also safety sensitive and is subject to random drug and alcohol testing.

Examination Information: Eligible candidates will be notified of the exact time and place of the examination. The examination process will consist of three parts to include a written examination, performance assessment and/or interview, and record evaluation for internal candidates. The record evaluation will be weighted as 15% of the overall examination score for candidates who have passed the written and performance assessment/interview. Record evaluation information will be obtained from the candidate's supervisor. Candidates must meet all record evaluation criteria in order to gain the full 15% weighting. . Candidates must pass the written examination to be eligible to proceed to additional parts of the examination process required to establish the eligibility for the position. Candidates will become eligible based on the composite scores from each part of the examination process.
