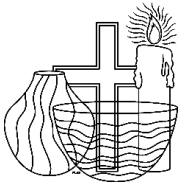

SPONSOR CERTIFICATE ...

A sponsor certificate is a document issued by the home parish of a person who has been asked to be a spiritual companion for a child or adult seeking to be baptized or confirmed in the Catholic Church. It provides the parish of the person to be baptized or confirmed evidence that he or she is eligible to be a sponsor.

All requests for sponsor certificates must be directed to a priest. Individuals must be registered and practicing members of this parish, at least 16 years of age, and have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation. If married, the marriage must have been accept-
