May God's blessings be yours this Epiphany season,

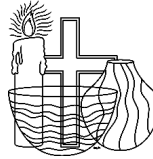

This week, in episode 8, "**Confession: the Struggle of Conversion**," we will take up the first of the two sacraments of healing: the Sacrament of Penance. God knew that few of us would persevere in our baptismal innocence, and so He gave us the Sacrament of Penance to restore us to grace when we have fallen into serious sin.
