The Corpus Christi Procession: a Catholic Tradition

Processing through the community with the Blessed Sacrament on the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ is a venerable Church tradition. The procession is an outward demonstration of Catholic faith and belief in the real presence of the risen Christ, under the appearance of the Consecrated Host. The Solemnity of Corpus Christi was introduced in the late 13th Century.



The procession is made up of clergy, Catholic groups and organizations, lay people, and children in First Communion dress. The Holy Eucharist is held in a processional monstrance carried by a priest or bishop. The monstrance itself is protected by a decorated canopy. Pope St. John Paul II urged all Catholics to participate in Corpus Christi processions as a public profession of their faith in the real presence of Christ in the Holy Sacrament.

Today we celebrate Corpus Christi, an opportunity for us to reflect upon the awesome gift of the Eucharist. It is a memorial of the love of Christ for us. The Most Blessed Sacrament will be carried in procession following the 11:30 Mass this Sunday. Corpus Christi Processions were instituted in the 13th century by Pope Urban IV.

As we reflect upon this wonderful gift of Christ, let us take a moment to think about the ways we can show our gratitude to Our Lord for remaining always on our altars in the Most Blessed Sacrament:

- Let us be reverent when we genuflect when entering or leaving our pews, or when we pass before the tabernacle.
- Perhaps we might stop in and pay a visit to our Lord. He is our best Friend; shall we not pay Him a visit once in a while?
- Perhaps we might sign up for a Holy Hour each week. Did Our Lord not ask, could you not watch one hour with me?
- Perhaps we might be part of our 40 Hours Devotions.
- Perhaps we might also reflect upon our preparation for receiving Jesus in Holy Communion.

The Lord has given us such a precious gift.
Let us never take Him for granted.

I offer congratulations to our Academy graduates! Well done! Congratulations also go out to students of the Lyceum and Benedictine High School who graduated from our church recently and to all of the high school and college graduates of our parish. God bless you and know of our prayers.

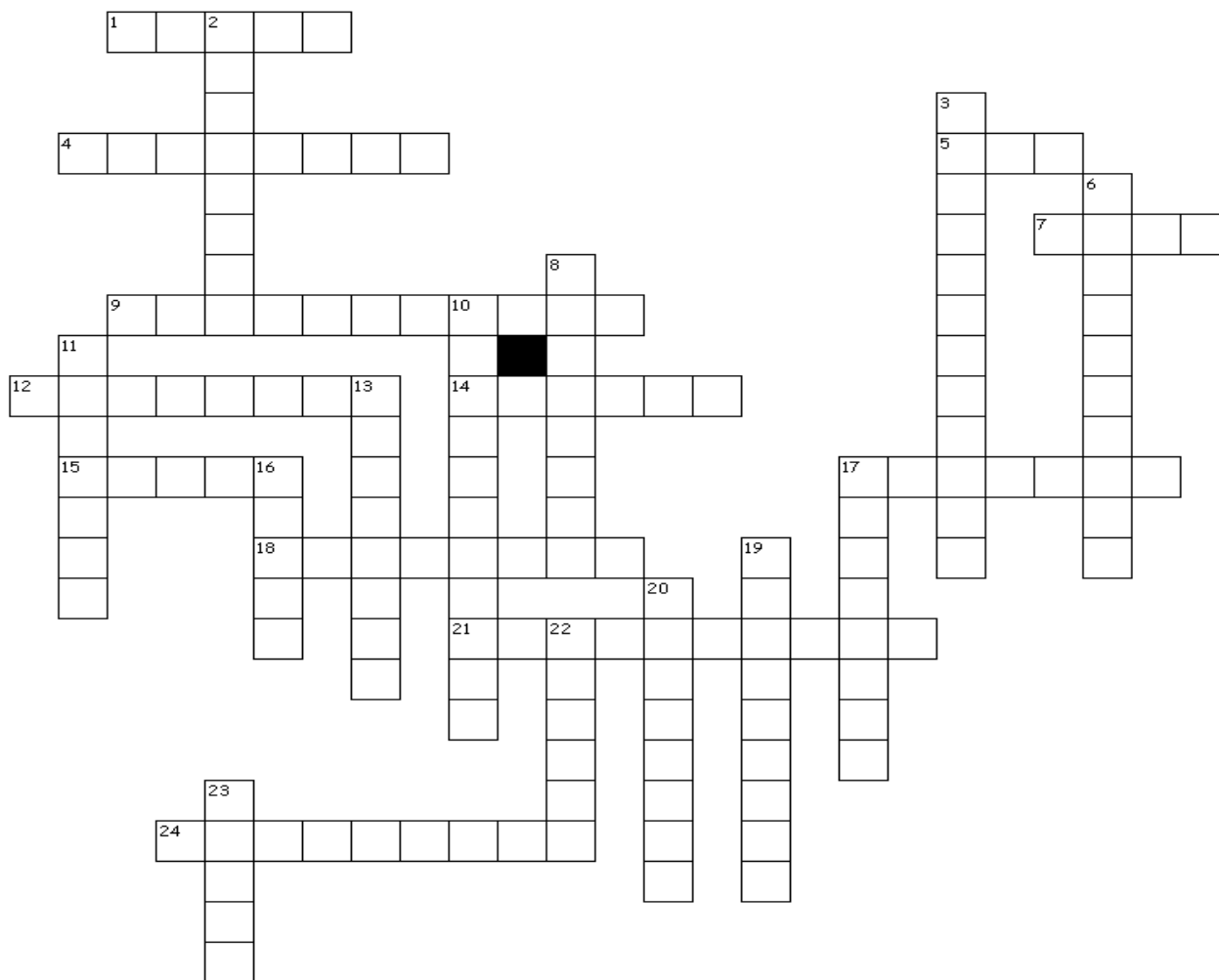
