*My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,*

Happy Feast Day! This weekend we are celebrating our Patronal Feast: The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Although the feast is celebrated on Friday, a parish, during Ordinary Time, may transfer the celebration to the following Sunday.

The name of our parish is so fitting. When St. Margaret Mary and St. Gregory the Great merged we were in need of a new name. It was to St. Margaret Mary that our Blessed Lord revealed His Most Sacred Heart. Our Lord said to her, "Behold this Heart, which notwithstanding the burning love for man with which it is consumed and exhausted, meets with no other return from the generality of "Christians than sacrilege, contempt, indifference, and ingratitude." It would seem that the condition of the world today needs this devotion more than ever.

The Feast of the Sacred Heart was established in order that the faithful might honor with more devotion and zeal the love of Jesus Christ, who suffered and died for our redemption and who gave us Himself in Holy Communion.

Please note that the 5:00 p.m. Mass will be a Solemn High Mass in Latin. I hope that you might use this Patronal Feast to rekindle in your hearts a great and awesome love of Christ.

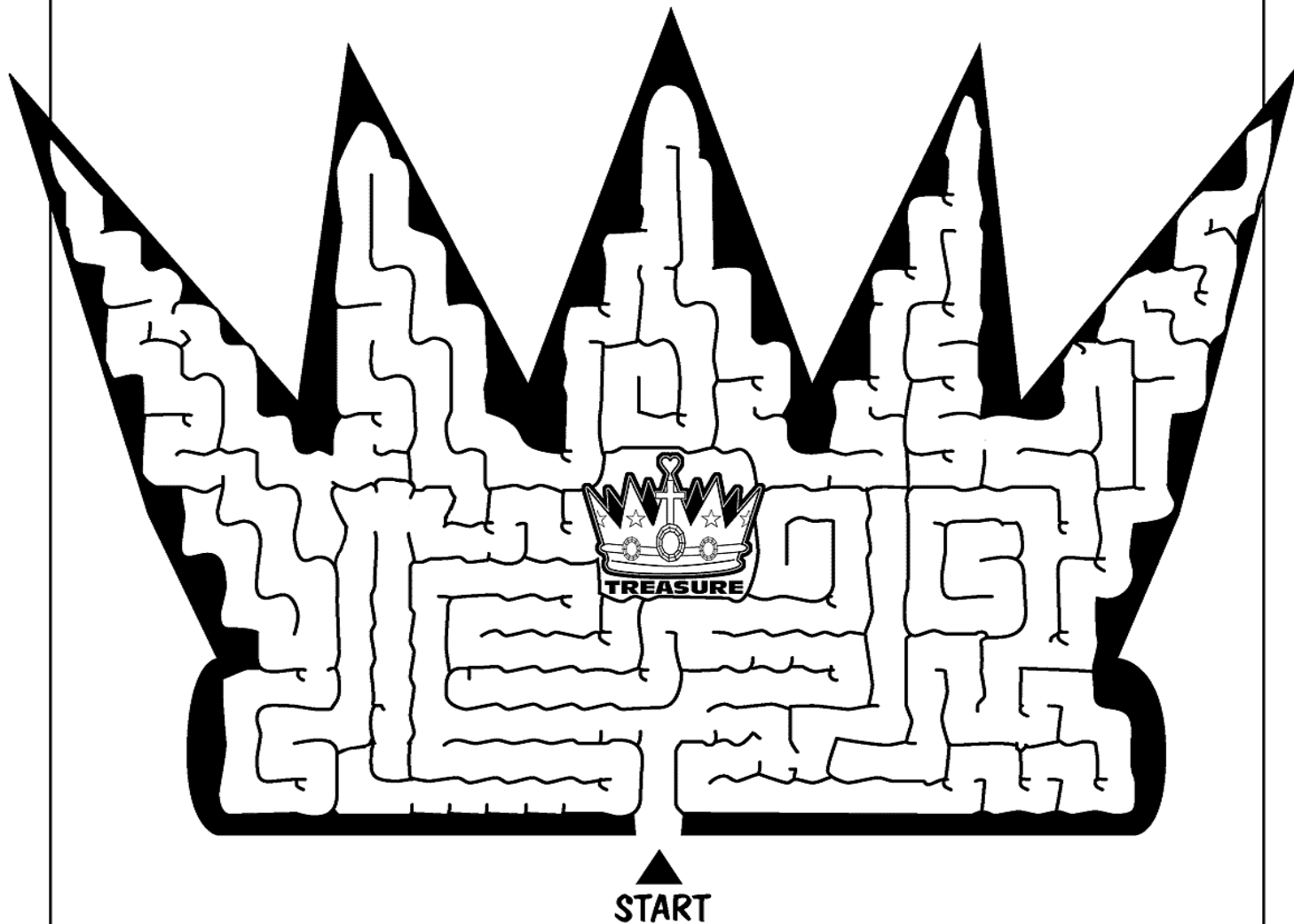
