## FROM THE DESK OF THE PAROCHIAL VICAR ...

***"The Kingdom of God is at Hand."*** (Lk 10:9)

Last weekend's gospel passage began on a rather somber note where St. Luke wrote:

"When the days for Jesus' being taken up were fulfilled, He resolutely determined to journey to Jerusalem." (Lk 9:15)

We know what that meant. Jesus had decided that the time was NOW! He was about to begin that one-way journey to His coming passion, death, and resurrection. Last week we heard that Jesus continued to call individuals to "Follow Me," and we heard various responses to that call. Now, this weekend, in chapter 10 of Luke's Gospel we have read to us that "...the Lord appointed seventy-two others whom He sent ahead of Him in pairs to every town and place He intended to visit." (Lk 10:1)

What if you, along with another person (a friend or a family member, etc.) who shared your desire to spread Jesus' message, were one of those thirty-six pairs (36 x 2 = 72) setting out? Recent adverse Supreme Court decisions that defy God's plan for what marriage is certainly would make a pair of disciples realize that they have a difficult task. The fact that only about 30% of Catholics attend Mass with regularity would also indicate that the task is going to be hard. An almost universal present-day view of the gift of our human sexuality to be merely a recreational activity, plus greed, and the prevalent abuse of alcohol and drugs are more signs that proclaiming the message of Jesus will not be easy. And all of this is accompanied by society's lack of regard for the very gift of life itself from God.

Twice in today's gospel passage Jesus states that "The kingdom of God is at hand." God is near. That closeness of God does not have to be interpreted or understood in a threatening way; not necessarily does God's proximity mean impending doom. The kingdom of God begins in each proclaimer's heart. God's mercy and love are still available. While one person might feel inclined to talk of coming punishment, another proclaimer might speak of the opportunity to still change things. Think about Jesus' statement. What mood or attitude do you feel as you proclaim THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS AT HAND?

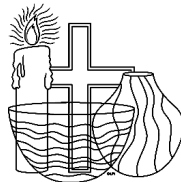
