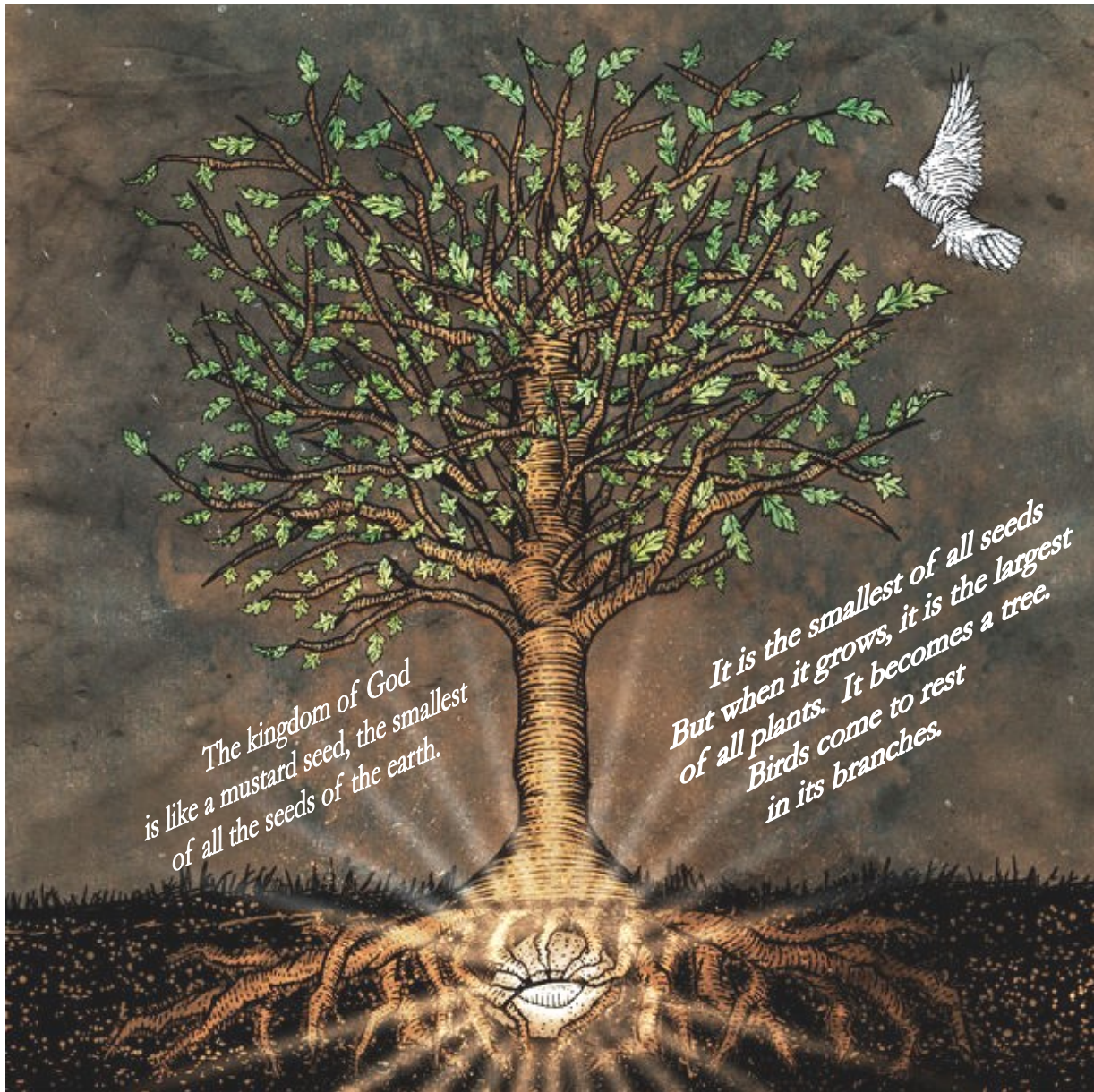

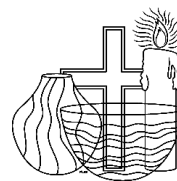

**THINKING OF BECOMING CATHOLIC?**

Are you searching for an opportunity to learn more about the Catholic faith? RCIA (the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a nine-month-long period of formation for those who want to convert to Catholicism.

Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish has a combined program with our cluster parish, Holy Rosary. Sessions are Tuesday evenings from 7 to 9 p.m. in the adult education room, lower level of the Montessori School at Holy Rosary. The first gathering this year is September 9. Candidates are received into the Church at the Easter Vigil, 2015, and sessions continue in a period of mystagogia between Easter and Pentecost Sunday to assist the neophytes in deepening their faith.
