RCIA (the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a nine-month-long period of formation for men and women who want to convert to Catholicism. We have a combined program with our cluster parish, Holy Rosary. Sessions are at Holy Rosary Tuesday evenings, 7-9 p.m., in their adult education room, lower level of the Montessori School. First session is September 9. Candidates are received into the Church at the Easter Vigil, 2015, and sessions continue in a period of mystagogia between Easter and Pentecost Sunday to assist the neophytes in deepening their faith.
