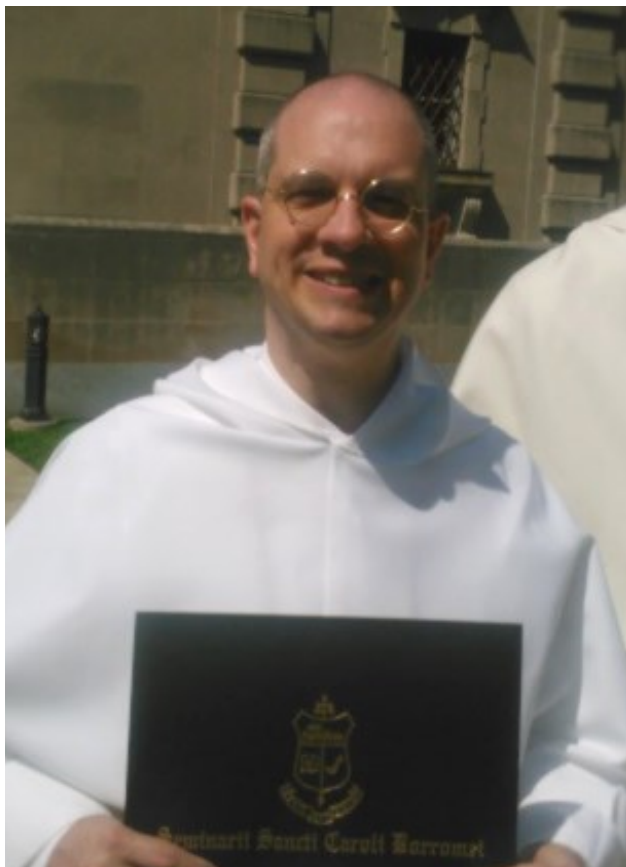

These are offered at the parish on the 4th Sunday of January, April, July and October at 1:00 p.m. in Mary's Room. Pre-registration is required. Call the Parish Office.

Marriages:

Engaged couples should make their arrangements with the priest at least 6 to 12 months in advance of their wedding.

Funerals: Call the Parish Office to arrange date and time.

Holy Communion for the Homebound:

Please call the Parish Office whenever a family member is seriously ill or hospitalized. Arrangements can be made to bring Holy Communion to the homebound weekly or monthly.

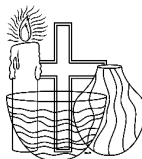
Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

RCIA is the process by which persons who were never baptized, were baptized in another Christian tradition, or baptized Catholic and never completed the initiation process by receiving the Sacraments of Holy Eucharist and Confirmation, become members of the Church.
