## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK ...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I am sure that you have heard of the horrible tragedy that occurred in the Navy Yard in Washington.

Our good friend and former associate of St. Margaret Mary Parish, His Excellency, the Most Reverend Timothy P. Broglio, J.C.D., Archbishop for the Military Services, issued the following statement concerning the shootings:

“With all people of good will, I am shocked and deeply saddened by the terrible loss of life this morning at the Navy Yard. I have often visited and celebrated the Eucharist there. It is a familiar place. I also prayed for the victims, the wounded, and their families at the noon Mass at the Archdiocesan Pastoral Center. Somehow we must restore the notion of respect for life into the fabric of the Nation. When the uniqueness of the human person created in the image and likeness of God is universally recognized, the possibility of a mass shooting is more remote.”

*Let us continue to pray for the victims, their families,  
and for peace in our troubled world.*

## HELPING HANDS FOR HAITI

Our parish is in its second year of the diaper project for the babies in Haiti. Because of the devastation from the earthquake there, the people have no room to dispose of diapers, so they must use cloth diapers for their babies. These are given to the moms of newborns when they leave the hospital. To date, we have made over 1,000 diapers from donated materials. Currently we have a need for the terry cloth used for the soakers. Can you help out? Maybe you have some usable fabrics hiding away in the attic, basement, or a cedar chest.

Also needed are volunteers to prepare the materials, assemble and sew these diapers. Materials and very simple patterns and instruction sheets are available in Mary's Room in the back of the Church.
